

## DAVID DOUGLAS AWARD

### Terms & Conditions

1. Candidates Young Engineers (normally up to 30 years of age), and Postgraduate Engineering Students, who are preferably members of a recognised professional Institution.
2. Award Frequency: Annual
3. Value of Award Maximum of £1,000 to be awarded on the recommendation of the Adjudicators
4. Award Criteria Normally:
  - i Technical Paper on an Engineering topic
  - ii The Paper to be 2,500 to 5,000 words, 5 – 8 illustrations and typewritten.
  - iii Normally, Single author paper
  - iv The Award winner(s) to present the Paper(s) to the Trustees on an appropriate date.
  - v The Paper to be published on the SWIEET2007 website.
5. Adjudication Criteria
  - i Statement and Attainment of Project Aims (10%)
  - ii Awareness of previous work and appropriate theory (20%)
  - iii Technical Content (50%)
  - iv Presentation and Style (20%)
6. Submission Date: David Douglas Award Competition date is March
7. Adjudication Panel: Chairman of the David Douglas Award Committee and other Trustees of the SWIEET2007 with power to co-opt appropriate expertise.
